**Bandol, France**

Tucked into a sheltered bay on the Côte d'Azur, Bandol is stocked with all the lavish trappings of a French seaside resort: designer shops, a beach-hugging coastline, a photogenic marina and a lovely promenade fringed by pine and oleander. A popular holiday destination, the town is known for its superb rosé wine.

**Ajaccio, Corsica, France**

An island of stunning, rugged countryside, Corsica boasts scenic gorges, lush pine forests, aromatic maquis shrubs and fascinating towns. One of its most famous towns is bustling, colorful Ajaccio, renowned as the birthplace of Napoleon.

**Cagliari, Sardinia, Italy**

A delightful city spread over seven hills, Sardinia's capital offers both modern and old attractions, from attractive boutique-lined boulevards to the medieval Castello district. Cagliari's 2,000 years of history is revealed in archaeological remains, Pisan towers, Byzantine churches and many fine museums. Nearby is one of Sardinia's best beaches, Il Poetto—perfect for a city-side swim.

**Palma de Mallorca, Spain**

Dominating the horizon and overlooking the harbor, the Palma Cathedral and Bellver Castle offer a striking first glimpse of Palma, the stunning capital of Mallorca. Winding alleys and cobbled streets characterize Old Palma, while charming windmills and an impressive 18th-century manor house beckon from the verdant countryside.

**Ibiza, Spain**

A playground for European bohemians in the 1960s, today Ibiza—nicknamed the “White Island”—is a holiday hotspot with whitewashed houses, a beach-blessed coastline, bars, restaurants and chic shops. The capital of Ciudad de Ibiza offers a multitude of diversions, especially in the historic Dalt Vila district. Historic sites include the 16th-century Castle of Ibiza and the Museum of Contemporary Art.

**Valencia, Spain**

Once an industrial port, today Spain's third-largest city celebrates its innovation and revival, epitomized in the monumental City of Arts and Sciences. Best known as the birthplace of paella, Valencia is also famed for its unique mix of Baroque cathedrals, futuristic architecture, lively plazas, lush parks and sprawling beaches.
